WIPS Training Number 3: A Deeper Dive: The Apprenticeship PIRL & Schema, Valid Values & Logic Rules

This series was developed to prepare Apprenticeship grantee reporting teams from Apprenticeship State Expansion Grant (ASE), State Apprenticeship Expansion (SAE2020), and Youth Apprenticeship Readiness Grants (YARG) grants to utilize the Workforce Integrated Performance System (WIPS) to report participant data. Check with your program to confirm the implementation date/s. If you have multiple awarded grants, they are considered active, and grantees should be operating and managing them concurrently.
